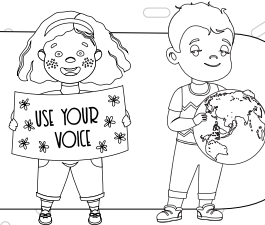

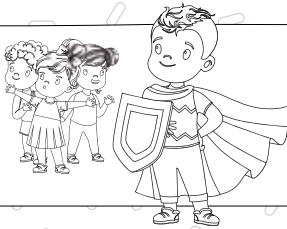

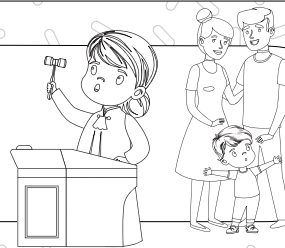

A safety network are the people you can trust if you feel unsafe or uncomfortable.
